# Цель реализации адаптированной основной образовательной программы среднего общего образования.

#### Пояснительная записка

Адаптированная программа 5 класс по предмету английский язык составлена на основании заключения ПМПК № 334 и на основе: - О внесении изменений и дополнений в приказ Министра образования и науки Республики Казахстан от 3 апреля 2013 года № 115 «Об утверждении типовых учебных программ по общеобразовательным предметам, курсам по выбору и факультативам для общеобразовательных организаций»-приказ № 51 от 5 февраля 2020 года -«Об утверждении государственных общеобязательных стандартов дошкольного воспитания и обучения, начального, основного среднего и общего среднего, технического и профессионального, послесреднего образования» (далее – ГОСО) (приказ Министра просвещения Республики Казахстан от 3 августа 2022 года № 348); -«Об утверждении типовых учебных планов начального, основного среднего, общего среднего образования Республики Казахстан» (приказ МОН РКот 8 ноября 2012 года № 500); - «Об утверждении перечня учебников для организаций среднего образования, учебно-методических комплексов для дошкольных организаций, организаций среднего образования, в том числе в электронной форме» (приказ МОН РК от 22 мая 2020 года № 216); Основная цель обучения предмету «Английский язык» – заложить основу формирования функциональной грамотности, обеспечить развитие всех видов речевой деятельности: аудирования (слушания), говорения, чтения, письма как показателей общей культуры человека.
